ConocoPhillips Alaska, Inc., Colville River Unit, CD2 Pad Expansion for Fiord West Development

The Alaska Department of Natural Resources, Division of Oil and Gas (Division), has received a Unit Plan of Operations Amendment Application from ConocoPhillips Alaska, Inc. (CPAI), dated October 2, 2017, to place 5.8 acres of gravel fill and install 32 well conductors at the existing Colville Delta 2 (CD2) pad within the Colville River Delta Unit (CRU). The CD2 Pad is located approximately 8.5 miles north of Nuiqsut Alaska. The Division is providing public notice and an opportunity to comment under AS 38.05.035.

Location: Section 2, Township 11 North, Range 4 East, Umiat Meridian.

Project Description: CPAI requests authorization to place approximately 73,000 cubic yards of gravel fill material onto 5.8 acres of tundra to expand the west side of the existing CD2 pad in the CRU. The gravel placement is necessary to support up to 32 additional wells in CRU along with associated infrastructure. CPAI proposes to drill the additional wells in a phased approach based on rig availability between various drilling operations. Project work is expected to begin on January 1, 2018 and be completed by March 31, 2020.
