Armstrong Energy, LLC., Pikka Unit – Pikka 2, 2017-2018 Winter Drilling Program

The Alaska Department of Natural Resources, Division of Oil and Gas (Division), has received a Unit Plan of Operations (LONS 17-003) Amendment Application from Armstrong Energy, LLC (Armstrong), dated October 2, 2017 to drill an oil and gas exploration well on State of Alaska oil and gas leases. The Division is providing public notice and an opportunity to comment under AS 38.05.035.

Location: Umiat Meridian, Township 11N, Range 5E, Section 35

Project Description: Armstrong requests approval to drill and test an exploration well on State of Alaska oil and gas leases on the North Slope of Alaska. The proposed drilling location is located approximately 6 miles northeast of Nuiqsut. Drilling rig, maintenance buildings, storage connexes, camps, office buildings, a communication tower, and other small temporary support structure will be located on the ice pad approximately one-half mile from the banks of the Colville River. A construction ice pad will be located at the start of the ice road, near the Mustang Pad, to support 13.5 mile long ice road construction, early mobilization, and maintenance. The construction pad will also contain a temporary camp and associated support facilities.

A copy of the final decision will be sent to any person who provides written comments.

The deadline for comments is 4:30 p.m. Alaska Standard Time on November 23, 2017.
