BPXA requests approval to place gravel fill into Waters of the United States to expand Q Pad, located in the Western Operating Area of the Prudhoe Bay Unit. The purpose of this project is to provide the necessary access for the safe maneuvering of larger drilling rigs to access existing wells on the drilling pad.
