**Accumulate Energy Alaska, Inc., Bravo #1 and Charlie #1 Exploration Wells**

The Alaska Department of Natural Resources, Division of Oil and Gas (Division), received a Lease Plan of Operations application from Accumulate Energy Alaska, Inc. (AEA) to drill two exploration oil wells (Bravo #1 and Charlie #1). The Division assigned the project number: LONS 17-004 and is providing the public notice and an opportunity to comment under Alaska Statute (AS) 38.05.035(e)(1)(C)(ii).

AEA requests approval to drill Bravo #1 and Charlie #1 exploration oil wells in support of the Icewine project during winter 2018. The proposed wells will be drilled from ice pads about 24 and 27 miles west of the Franklin Bluffs Pad, and will be accessed via a tundra winter road starting at Mile Post 386.50 Dalton Highway.
