The Alaska Department of Natural Resources (ADNR), Division of Oil and Gas (Division), has received a Unit Plan of Operations application (LONS 17-005) from ConocoPhillips Alaska, Inc. (CPAI), dated November 2, 2017, to conduct exploration at a location in the Colville River Unit (CRU) in the Colville River Delta area. The Division is providing public notice and an opportunity to comment under AS 38.05.035.

CPAI requests authorization to conduct exploration drilling in the CRU in the Colville River Delta area. The exploration well will be located approximately 2.8 miles west of Nuiqsuit. Drilling will be conducted from an ice pad constructed on an island between the main and Nechelik Channel in the Colville River Delta. The project will be accessed via ice road. A generator will supply electricity for the project via ice-encased transmission line from an ice pad located approximately one mile north of the exploration drill site.
