MINERAL ORDER No. 1126
Closing Lands to Mineral Entry

- I. Name of Mineral Order: ADL 418975
- II. Reason for Mineral Order: This mineral order is based upon the attached Finding of the Commissioner and the written justification contained in the Point Thomson Export Pipeline Right-of-Way Lease, ADL 418975, Commissioner's Analysis and Final Decision dated (*To Be Determined after publication and notice of Proposed Decision*).
- III. Location and Legal Description: This Mineral Order shall cover the operational right-of-way which shall be a 100-foot wide right-of-way, situated 50 feet on either side of the Vertical Support Members (VSM) centerline, beginning at a point 50 feet east of the flange of the pig launcher where the export pipeline exits the Point Thomson Central Processing Facility (point of origin), within Section 34, Township 10 North, Range 23 East, Umiat Meridian; then continuing in a westerly direction across the following lands:
- Township 10 North, Range 23 East, Umiat Meridian, Sections 31, 32, 34
Township 9 North, Range 23 East, Umiat Meridian, Sections 3, 4, 5, 6
Township 10 North, Range 22 East, Umiat Meridian, Sections 34, 35, 36
Township 9 North, Range 22 East, Umiat Meridian, Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6
Township 9 North, Range 21 East, Umiat Meridian, Sections 1, 2, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 18
Township 9 North, Range 20 East, Umiat Meridian, Sections 8, 9, 13, 14, 15, 16
- The right-of-way terminates in a 50-foot buffer at the flange of the valve where the Point Thomson Export Pipeline connects to the Badami Sales Oil Pipeline (point of termination).
- IV. Mineral Order: This order is subject to valid existing rights and is issued under the authority granted by AS 38.05.185 – AS 38.05.275 to the Department of Natural Resources. In accordance with AS 38.05.185(a), I find that the best interests of the State of Alaska and its residents are served by closure of the land described in this mineral order to entry under mineral location and mining laws of the State of Alaska. The above described lands are hereby **closed** to entry under the locatable mineral and mining laws of the State of Alaska.
