CHANGE TO EXHIBIT B LINE LIST

The Commissioner of the Department of Natural Resources received an amendment request from Alaska Gasline Development Corporation, lessee for the Alaska Stand Alone Gas Pipeline/ASAP (ASAP), to amend the ASAP Right-of-Way (ROW) Lease. The proposed amendment updates the Exhibit B Line List as incorporated into the lease, identifying the project ROW location on State lands.

The amendment request proposes several changes to the lease:

1. Realignment of the mainline pipeline, referred to as Version 6.1. The ASAP mainline originates in Deadhorse and terminates in the Point MacKenzie area in the Mat-Su Borough. Please see the mainline line list and maps for further details.
2. Realignment of the Fairbanks lateral pipeline, referred to as Version 4.1. Please see the Fairbanks lateral line list and maps for further details.
3. Increasing the construction corridor from 100 feet to a nominal 120 feet.

The right-of-way lease is only applicable to state-owned lands (excluding lands owned or administered by University of Alaska, Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority or Alaska Railroad Corporation).

A proposed decision accepting the updated Exhibit B Line List has been prepared and is available for the public to review. Any comments must be submitted in writing to the State Pipeline Coordinator's Section (SPCS) before 5:00 p.m. on January 18, 2017.
