

**AMENDMENT OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE  
FOR THE  
TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE  
ADL 63574**

**BRIDGE ABUTMENT GUIDE BANK EXTENSION  
AT TSINA RIVER, PIPELINE MILEPOST 767**

This is an Amendment to Exhibit D, Description of the Right-of-Way for Related Facilities of the RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE, ADL 63574, hereinafter referred to as AMENDMENT.

The RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE dated May 3, 1974, ADL 63574, was recorded in the Valdez Recording District as Document No. 1979-000574-0, Book 86, Pages 802 through 908, on May 15, 1979. The RENEWAL AND AMENDMENT OF RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE AND ASSOCIATED RIGHTS, ADL 63574, which became effective May 2, 2004, was recorded in the Valdez Recording District as Document No. 2002-001280-0, Book 152, Pages 750 through 779, on December 17, 2002.

This AMENDMENT is made and entered into and becomes effective this 20 day of June, 2016, by and between the STATE OF ALASKA located at 3651 Penland Parkway, Anchorage, Alaska 99508, acting through the Commissioner of Natural Resources, hereinafter referred to as COMMISSIONER, and Alyeska Pipeline Service Company as agent for the Trans-Alaska Pipeline System (TAPS) owner companies located at P.O. Box 196660, MS 502, Anchorage, Alaska 99519-6660, hereinafter referred to as LESSEE.

WHEREAS, the LESSEE has applied to amend the existing Right-of-Way Lease ADL 63574, to include additional State of Alaska land to extend the erosion control guidebank attached to the left abutment of TAPS Access Road 7 APL-2 bridge that crosses the Tsina River, near Pipeline Milepost 767. The additional land is necessary for protecting the integrity of the bridge, which provides access for emergency response, routine maintenance activities and the existing TAPS cathodic protection station.

NOW THEREFORE, the COMMISSIONER and LESSEE agree to amend the RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE, ADL 63574, to include the lands within the Valdez Recording District described as:



SW4NE4 Section 9, Township 8 South, Range 2 West, Copper River Meridian, Alaska, 125' x 250' area along and adjacent to the left bank of the Tsina River and adjacent to the existing TAPS Access Road 7 APL-2 right-of-way, approximately 0.72 acres of State land.

The lands described above are incorporated into and made a part of the RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE dated May 3, 1974, ADL 63574, and the RENEWAL AND AMENDMENT OF RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE AND ASSOCIATED RIGHTS, ADL 63574, effective May 2, 2004.


The lands needed to extend the guidebank attached to the left abutment of the TAPS Access Road 7 APL-2 bridge that crosses the Tsina River may be less than those described above. After construction, Alyeska Pipeline Service Company will submit an as-built survey for the Commissioner's approval. The as-built survey will show the right-of-way addition in relation to the boundaries of the existing TAPS right-of-way.

Pursuant to Section 1.d.(ii) of the TAPS Lease, approval by the Commissioner and acceptance of such approval by APSC of the final as-built survey of the project area shall operate as a release of all interests of APSC in lands not included in the final as-built survey. Exhibit D, Right-of-Way for Related Facilities of the RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE, ADL 63574, will be amended to reflect the final as-built survey.

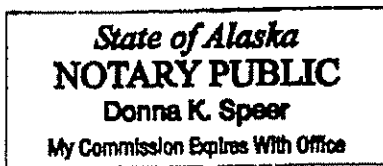
