

**AMENDMENT OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE
FOR THE
TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE
ADL 63574**

This is an Amendment to Exhibit D Description of the Right-of-Way for Related Facilities of the RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE dated May 3, 1974, ADL 63574, which was recorded in the Fairbanks Recording District in Book 149 Pages 0799 through 0905 on July 16, 1979, hereinafter referred to as AMENDMENT. This AMENDMENT is made and entered into and becomes effective this 10th day of October, 1995 by and between the STATE OF ALASKA located at 411 West 4th Avenue, Suite 2C, Anchorage, Alaska 99501 acting through the Commissioner of Natural Resources hereinafter referred to as COMMISSIONER, and Alyeska Pipeline Service Company as agent for Amerada Hess Pipeline Corporation, ARCO Transportation Alaska, Inc., BP Pipelines (Alaska) Inc., Exxon Pipeline Company, Mobile Alaska Pipeline Company, Phillips Alaska Pipeline Corporation, and Unocal Pipeline Company located at 1835 South Bragaw Street, Mailstop-569, Anchorage, Alaska 99512 hereinafter referred to as LESSEE.

WHEREAS, the LESSEE has applied to amend the existing Right-of-Way Lease ADL 63574 to include additional shoreland within the Fairbanks Recording District for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a new diversion dike that extends from the pipeline right-of-way at pipeline milepost (PLMP) 196 into the Dietrich River floodplain. The purpose of the diversion dike is to control river bank erosion and protect the Trans-Alaska Pipeline System (TAPS) by preventing the development of an active river channel over the buried pipeline at this location. The diversion dike will be situated within the NW1/4 of Section 15, of Township 34 North, Range 10 West, Fairbanks Meridian, Alaska. The shoreland requested for construction of the dike consists of approximately 3.4 acres.

NOW THEREFORE, the COMMISSIONER and LESSEE agree to amend the RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE, ADL 63574 to include the shorelands described as:

Township 34 North, Range 10 West, Fairbanks Meridian, Alaska.

Those shorelands lying below the ordinary high water mark of the Dietrich River within the NW1/4 of Section 15 within the following described area:

A 300 foot by 500 foot area centered on the centerline of the new dike intersecting the westerly Trans Alaska Pipeline right-of-way boundary line opposite pipeline station 10344+63, containing 3.4 acres, more or less, as depicted on the drawing submitted with the application labeled "Plan - Limits of Construction - Proposed Spur Dike and Pilot Channel at PLMP 196.0 Along the Dietrich River - Sheet 2 of 3 - Dated Jan. 4, 1993".

Located within the Fairbanks Recording District.
