Dear Mr. Warthen:

By letter dated January 27, 2016, NordAq Energy, Inc., operator and sole working interest owner of the Tiger Eye Unit, notified the Division of Oil and Gas that it was voluntarily terminating the unit. I hereby approve the voluntary termination of the Tiger Eye Unit under 11 AAC 83.336(c).

An eligible person affected by this decision may request reconsideration of it in accordance with 11 AAC 02. Any request for reconsideration must be received within 20 calendar days after the date of "issuance" of this decision, as defined in 11 AAC 02.040(c) and (d), and may be mailed or delivered to Andrew Mack, Acting Commissioner, Department of Natural Resources, 550 W 7th Avenue, Suite 1400, Anchorage, Alaska 99501; faxed to 1-907-269-8918; or sent by electronic mail to dnr.appeals@alaska.gov. This decision takes effect immediately. An eligible person must first request reconsideration of this decision in accordance with 11 AAC 02 before appealing this decision to Superior Court. If the Commissioner does not act on a request for reconsideration within 30 days after issuance of this decision, the request for reconsideration is considered denied and this decision becomes a final administrative order and decision on the 31st day after issuance for the purposes of an appeal to Superior Court. A copy of 11 AAC 02 may be obtained from any regional information office of the Department of Natural Resources.
