Subject: Request to Amend LAS 29590 for Access and Drill Boreholes at Proposed Material Source Exploration Areas on State Land for the Winter 2015 ASAP Project

Dear Mr. Jakubczak:

The Alaska Gasline Development Corporation (AGDC) is planning to continue borehole drilling as part of a material exploration program in the vicinity of the Alaska Stand Alone Pipeline/ASAP alignment. The geotechnical program consists of drilling boreholes, collecting soil samples, and conducting periodic site visits for equipment maintenance and data monitoring for boreholes along the alignment and material exploration sites.

AGDC is requesting an amendment to LAS 29590 for access and to drill boreholes in proposed material exploration areas on State land during winter 2015. The requested permit term is through December 31, 2016; however, actual borehole drilling dates are expected January 2, 2015 to April 30, 2015.

The material source name, location, number of boreholes, drilling method, and access is included in Table 1. Work will occur as detailed in the attached description and maps.
