NOTICE OF CHANGE OF SERVICE
OLIKTOK PIPELINE RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE - ADL 411731

The Department of Natural Resources (DNR), State Pipeline Coordinator's Office (SPCO) received an application from the Oliktok Pipeline Company requesting authorization for a change of service for the Oliktok Pipeline to discontinue transporting natural gas liquids and return to transporting natural gas. The change of service will not require any additional acreage for the Oliktok Pipeline Right-of-Way Lease, ADL 411731. The application included an updated basis of design document (Revision 1, October 15, 2013). The documents are available at the SPCO website: <http://dnr.alaska.gov/commis/pco>. The public may obtain hard copies of the letter of application and supporting documents, at cost, from the SPCO.

Pursuant to Alaska Statute 38.35.015, the DNR Commissioner issued the Oliktok Pipeline Right-of-Way Lease on June 1, 1986. The pipeline begins adjacent to the BP Exploration Alaska-operated Skid 50 near the Trans Alaska Pipeline System Pump Station 1 and is currently approved to transport natural gas liquids from Prudhoe Bay to the Kuparuk Central Processing Facility (CPF-1). Start-up of the natural gas service is dependent upon the needs of the gas customer. Anticipated start-up may occur as early as May 15, 2014.

Section 1(c) of the lease requires the Commissioner's approval prior to the pipeline transporting other products. The State Pipeline Coordinator, delegated by the DNR Commissioner to administer the lease, intends to approve the request to transport natural gas. All comments must be submitted in writing to the address below by 5:00 p.m. on November 29, 2013.
