NOTICE OF RIGHT-OF-WAY AMENDMENT APPLICATION

ALASKA GASLINE DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION

The State Pipeline Coordinator, pursuant to Alaska Statute (AS) 38.35.070, hereby gives notice that the Alaska Gasline Development Corporation (AGDC) submitted a request to amend their right-of-way lease for the Alaska Stand Alone Pipeline (ASAP) project.

The amendment request proposes several significant changes to the lease:

1. Realignment of the approximately 733-mile long mainline pipeline with approximately 379 miles on state-owned lands to reflect a common alignment with the AKLNG pipeline project (Prudhoe Bay to the Susitna River), referred to as version 6.1. The ASAP mainline originates in Deadhorse and terminates in the Point MacKenzie area in the Mat-Su Borough. Please see the mainline line list and maps for further details.
2. Realignment of the approximately 30-mile long Fairbanks lateral pipeline with approximately 20 miles on state-owned lands, referred to as version 4.1. Please see the Fairbanks lateral line list and maps for further details.
3. Increasing the construction corridor from 100 feet to 120 feet (with the exception of slope stability areas where the corridor will be wider) for both the mainline and the Fairbanks lateral.
4. Proposed total acreage for the project is approximately 8,885.
 - a. Mainline, with related facilities, is approx. 8,372 acres
 - b. Fairbanks lateral, with related facilities, is approx. 513 acres

The right-of-way lease is only applicable to state-owned lands managed by DNR (excluding Mental Health Trust lands). Title information within AGDC's application will be verified during the adjudication process.

AS 38.35.200 governs judicial review of a decision of the Commissioner:

AS 38.35.200 Judicial review of decisions of commissioner on application.

(a) An applicant or competing applicant or a person who has direct financial interest affected by the lease who raises objections within 60 days of the publication of notice under AS 38.35.070 are the only persons with standing to seek judicial review of a decision of the commissioner under AS 38.35.100.

(b) The only grounds for judicial review of a decision of the commissioner are

- 1. failure to follow the procedures set out in this chapter; or*
- 2. abuse of discretion so capricious, arbitrary, or confiscatory as to constitute a denial of due process.*

Any objections pursuant to 38.35.200 must be submitted in writing to the address below by 5:00 p.m. on **April 5, 2016**. Submittals must include how the commentor has standing under AS 38.35.200(a). Please contact the SPCS (see below) with inquiries about this amendment.
