NOTICE OF PROPOSED MATERIAL SALES
ADL 419400, ADL 419401, and ADL 419402

ALYESKA PIPELINE SERVICE COMPANY
TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE SYSTEM

This notice is to inform the public that Alyeska Pipeline Service Company (APSC), as agent for the Trans-Alaska Pipeline System (TAPS) owner companies, has applied to purchase gravel from three existing material sites, over a five year period, for the maintenance and operations of TAPS. The State Pipeline Coordinator's Office has issued a Preliminary Decision to issue new material sale contracts from the sites listed below. The representative sales price has been set at \$3.00 per cubic yard for material from each of these sites.

ADL 419400 - 4,000 cubic yards (cy) from OMS 63-1, located within T3N, R1W, FM, Sec. 33, that portion of the SW4 within 300 feet of the TAPS centerline, containing approximately 13 acres.

ADL 419401 – 10,000 cy from OMS 69-1R, located within T7N, R5W, FM, Sec. 23, SE4, containing approximately nine acres.

ADL 419402 – 5,000 cy from OMS 98-3.1, located within T28N, R12W, FM, Sec. 3, NE4NW4, and T29N, R12W, FM, Sec. 35, E2SW4, containing approximately 40 acres.

To be eligible to appeal the Final Finding and Decision, a person must provide written comments to the State Pipeline Coordinator's Office during this comment period for the Preliminary Decision. If public comment indicated the need for significant changes in the decision, then additional public notice will be given on or about July 6, 2012. If no significant change is required, then the Preliminary Decision, including any minor changes, will be issued as the Final Finding and Decision of the Department of Natural Resources after July 2, 2012, without further notice. The Final Finding and Decision will be available at the State Pipeline Coordinator's Office and will explain the appeal process. The Final Finding and Decision will be sent to any person who comments on this Preliminary Decision.
