This is an Amendment to Exhibit D Description of the Right-of-Way for Related Facilities of the RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE dated May 3, 1974, ADL 63574, hereinafter referred to as AMENDMENT.

The RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE dated May 3, 1974, ADL 63574 was recorded in the Barrow Recording District in Book 24 Pages 0001 through 0107 on July 16, 1979, and the RENEWAL AND AMENDMENT OF RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE AND ASSOCIATED RIGHTS, ADL 63574, was recorded as Document No. 2002-01065-0, on December 6, 2002 in the Barrow Recording District.

This AMENDMENT is made and entered into and becomes effective this 29th day of April, 2004 by and between the STATE OF ALASKA located at 411 West 4th Avenue, Suite 2C, Anchorage, Alaska 99501 acting through the Commissioner of Natural Resources hereinafter referred to as COMMISSIONER, and Alyeska Pipeline Service Company as agent for the Trans-Alaska Pipeline System owner companies located at P.O. Box 196660, MS 596, Anchorage, Alaska 99519-6660 hereinafter referred to as LESSEE.


WHEREAS, the LESSEE has applied to amend the existing Right-of-Way Lease ADL 63574 to include additional State of Alaska land for a temporary construction zone to accommodate the installation and maintenance of revetment structure on the west bank of the Sagavanirktok River at Pipeline Milepost (PLMP) 67.8. The revetment will enhance the integrity of the pipeline by preventing further encroachment of the Sagavanirktok River on a shunt box for a cathodic protection system and the buried pipeline in this location.

NOW THEREFORE, the COMMISSIONER and LESSEE agree to amend the RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE, ADL 63574 to include the lands within the Barrow Recording District described as:

The lands described above are incorporated into and made a part of the RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE dated May 3, 1974, ADL 63574 and RENEWAL AND AMENDMENT OF RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE AND ASSOCIATED RIGHTS, ADL 63574, effective May 2, 2004.


The lands needed to accommodate the revetment structure after construction will be substantially less than those described above. After construction, Alyeska Pipeline Service Company will submit an as-built drawing for the Commissioner's approval. The as-built drawing will tie the structures to the pipeline centerline. Upon Alyeska's acceptance of the Commissioner's approval of the as-built, Exhibit D Description of the Right-of-Way for Related Facilities of the RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE, ADL 63574 will be amended to reflect the final, amended legal description.


