**CATHODIC PROTECTION IMPROVEMENTS
SAGAVANIRKTOK RIVER, PIPELINE MILEPOST 67.7**

This is an Amendment to Exhibit D, Description of the Right-of-Way for Related Facilities of the RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE, ADL 63574, hereinafter referred to as AMENDMENT.

The RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE dated May 3, 1974, ADL 63574, was recorded in the Barrow Recording District in Book 24, Pages 1 through 107, on July 16, 1979. The RENEWAL AND AMENDMENT OF RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE AND ASSOCIATED RIGHTS, ADL 63574, which became effective May 2, 2004, was recorded in the Barrow Recording District as Document No. 2002-001065-0, Pages 001 through 030 on December 6, 2002.

This AMENDMENT is made and entered into and becomes effective this 2nd day of July, 2015, by and between the STATE OF ALASKA located at 3651 Penland Parkway, Anchorage, Alaska 99508, acting through the Commissioner of Natural Resources, hereinafter referred to as COMMISSIONER, and Alyeska Pipeline Service Company as agent for the Trans-Alaska Pipeline System (TAPS) owner companies located at P.O. Box 196660, MS 502 Anchorage, Alaska 99519-6660, hereinafter referred to as LESSEE.

WHEREAS, the LESSEE has applied to amend the existing Right-of-Way Lease, ADL 63574, to include additional State of Alaska land for the installation of a deep anode groundbed from a sparsely-vegetated gravel bar at the periphery of the Sagavanirktok River floodplain, just below the ordinary high water mark, adjacent to an existing TAPS Spur Dike. The deep anode groundbed will improve cathodic protection of the buried pipeline and protect the integrity of the buried pipeline.

NOW THEREFORE, the COMMISSIONER and LESSEE agree to amend the RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE, ADL 63574, to include the lands within the Barrow Recording District described as:



SE4SE4 Section 22, Township 1 South, Range 14 East, Umiat Meridian, Alaska, those lands below the Ordinary High Water Line of the Sagavanirktok River adjacent to the TAPS right-of-way boundary at Pipeline Milepost (PLMP) 67.7 Spur Dike, containing 0.8 acres, more or less.

The lands described above are incorporated into and made a part of the RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE, ADL 63574, dated May 3, 1974, and the RENEWAL AND AMENDMENT OF RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE AND ASSOCIATED RIGHTS, ADL 63574, effective May 2, 2004.

The lands needed to accommodate the deep anode groundbed after construction may be less than those described above. After construction, Alyeska Pipeline Service Company will submit an as-built survey for the Commissioner's approval. The as-built survey will show the right-of-way addition in relation to the boundaries of the existing TAPS right-of-way.

Pursuant to Section 1.d.(ii) of the RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE, ADL 63574, approval by the Commissioner and acceptance of such approval by APSC of the final as-built survey of the deep anode groundbed shall operate as a release of all interests of APSC in lands not included in the final as-built survey. Exhibit D, Right-of-Way for Related Facilities of the RIGHT-OF-WAY LEASE FOR THE TRANS-ALASKA PIPELINE, ADL 63574, will be amended to reflect the final as-built survey.
