BEAUFORT SEA AREAWIDE 2011W NORTH SLOPE AREAWIDE 2011W NORTH SLOPE FOOTHILLS AREAWIDE 2011 COMPETITIVE OIL AND GAS LEASE SALES

The Alaska Department of Natural Resources (ADNR), Division of Oil and Gas (DO&G), will offer state lands for competitive oil and gas leasing in the Beaufort Sea Areawide 2011W (BS 2011W), North Slope Areawide 2011W (NS 2011W), and North Slope Foothills Areawide 2011 (FH 2011) Oil and Gas Lease Sales on **December 7, 2011. Bid opening begins at 9:00 a.m.** at the Dena'ina Civic and Convention Center, 600 W. 7th Avenue, Anchorage, Alaska.

The Beaufort Sea Areawide sale area is divided into 573 tracts ranging in size from 640 to 5,760 acres. These tracts are located within the North Slope Borough and consist of state-owned tide and submerged lands in the Beaufort Sea between the Canadian border and Point Barrow. The southern fringe of the sale area includes some state-owned uplands lying between the NPR-A and the ANWR. Tracts adjacent to federal lands in the Outer Continental Shelf (OCS), the Arctic National Wildlife Refuge (ANWR), and the National Petroleum Reserve-Alaska (NPR-A) are being offered with different terms than all other tracts.

The North Slope Areawide sale area is divided into 1,225 tracts, ranging in size from 640 to 5,760 acres. For this sale, certain tracts have been subdivided into four parcels, A, B, C, and D. Tracts in this sale area are located within the North Slope Borough between the Canning River and the ANWR on the east and the Colville River and the NPR-A on the west. The southern boundary of the sale area is the Umiat Meridian baseline. The sale area is divided into three sub-regions: North, South, and Adjacent to Federal Lands (the NPR-A and the ANWR). Each sub-region is being offered with different terms.

The North Slope Foothills Areawide sale area is divided into 1,347 tracts ranging in size from 1,280 to 5,760 acres. These tracts are located between the ANWR and the NPR-A. The northern boundary of the sale area is the Umiat Meridian baseline and the southern boundary is the Gates of the Arctic National Park and Preserve.

North and South sub-regions – Years 1-7, \$10.00/acre; Years 8+, \$250.00/acre; except that beginning in the year after the year in which sustained production commences on this lease or the state otherwise determines in its sole discretion, upon request, that the lessee has exercised reasonable diligence in exploring and developing this lease the annual rental will be \$10.00 per acre or fraction of an acre. In evaluating a request to decrease rental based on the exercise of reasonable diligence, the state will consider the funds expended by the lessee to explore and develop this lease and the types of work completed by or on behalf of the lessee on this lease.

In support of a North Slope Areawide Sale, the director of DO&G issued a final written finding and decision on July 15, 2008 and on November 9, 2009, issued a final written finding supporting a Beaufort Sea Areawide Sale.
