Dear Explorers and Investors,

The State of Alaska offered three SALSA blocks for sale at the Fall of 2019 Competitive Oil and Gas Lease Sales. These unique lease sale blocks were groups of North Slope and Beaufort Sea Areawide lease sale tracts that were offered together as Special Alaska Lease Sale Areas (SALSA). The Division of Oil and Gas gathered and highlighted large amounts of publicly available data that bears on the SALSA areas. The presentation shared here was originally offered in support of the SALSA blocks offered. The SALSA effort has now run its course but the methods of locating useful data to support the evaluation of State lands remains. The original presentation is edited here to focus on the data. USGS, USBOM, USBLM, and energy industry archives are merged at the GMC to form a state-wide collection of 350,000 surface rock and sediment samples. Our catalogue of more than 198,000 processed slides contains a world-class palynology collection and numerous other microfossil, organic and petrographic thin sections, sediment, and thermochronology glass slides. Extensive geological and geochemical results derived third-party sampling of GMC materials are maintained in unreviewed data and reports


Filtered Time Migrated Full Stack Northshore 3D



SALSA Harrison Bay Bidding History






Tools for more information on Leases
